## Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: "Commentary for 'Canzoniere per Beatrice d'Este' by Gaspare Ambrogio Visconti", Academic discipline: L-FIL-LET/10 Italian literature, tutor prof. Tiziano Zanato, financed by the PRIN 2020 project "Poetry Collections from 15th-Century Northern Italy: Critical Editions and Commentaries" (Prot. 2020JXT3RB), CUP: H73C20000060001, Principal Investigator prof. Tiziano Zanato.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

#### Abstract

It is a matter of providing for a commentary of the "Canzoniere per Beatrice d'Este" by Gaspare Ambrogio Visconti (1461 - 1499), of which already exists a critical edition by Paolo Bongrani in 1979. It is comprised of 157 sonnets, preceded by a dedication and the apology of Love in prose, for whom it will be necessary to proceed to an exhaustive and complete commentary.

### Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold:

- Ph.D. in Italian studies and appropriate academic and professional CV.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

**Duration of contract:** 12 months (approximately starting: 1st October 2022).

**Stipend:** The research fellowship total amount is **19.367,00** Euros, including taxes and social charges.

#### **Evaluation**

Up to 100 points, specifically:

- For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60;
- For the interview, from 0 to 40.

Candidates are admitted to the interview if assessment of the qualifications and the possible tests results in a score equal to or greater than 42/60.

The following qualifications are considered as evaluation criteria:

- a) a list of the candidate's scientific publications;
- b) attendance certificates (or diplomas) of post-graduate specialization courses, obtained both in Italy and abroad; documented research activities related to the purpose of the call with contracts, scholarships or assignments in public and private entities both in Italy and abroad;
- c) experience of commentary on medieval or Renaissance vulgar poetic texts;
- d) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them see Article 5 of the competition available in Italian (link);
- e) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5 of the competition available in Italian (link).

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- Skills in exegesis of medieval and Renaissance vulgar poetic texts;
- Knowledge of editorial informatics;

- Editorial practice skills;
- Knowledge of English language.

At the end of his/her research activity, the research fellow is required to provide the Department with:

• The project of the commentary of the "Canzoniere per Beatrice d'Este" by Gaspare Ambrogio Visconti will have to reach the publication in an open access volume.
