Description

The "Centro temporaneo Progetto Ecosistema dell'Innovazione" at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia, in charge of the administrative management of the above mentioned project, invites applications for a fellowship in:

Title: Authenticity work in cultural destinations SSD or Research sector: SECS/P07 Scientific coordinator or supervisor: Prof.ssa Maria Lusiani Duration: 24 months Abstract:

The research project tackles the challenge for cultural destinations to develop and sustain believable authenticity claims (i.e. 'authenticity work'). Authenticity is a matter of concern for practitioners and researchers involved in the planning, marketing, and management of cultural tourism, and is often related to the 'objective' dimension, i.e. features of the object, site, or piece of heritage embodying historical and cultural value. However, authenticity is something that is also constructed (sociopolitical dimension) and experienced (phenomenological dimension) over time. From the perspective of management studies, the researcher is expected to investigate the interplay between the material/narrative/spatial practices of cultural destination managers in constructing authenticity claims, and the experience patterns of cultural destination audiences in living the site. Adopting a practice-based, qualitative research approach, the study will deliver a typology of authenticity works in cultural destinations, potentially distinguishing between cases of authenticity work in rather toutist-directed cultural destinations and in rather local community-directed cultural destinations. The researcher will be responsible for the establishment and upkeeping of an intense dialogue with professionals and business firms active in cultural destinations in the Veneto region. In this way, the research results will actively contribute to the transformation of the business models that currently shape the relationship between culture and tourism. Deliverables will include:

a literature review on authenticity and authenticity work in cultural/tourism destinations (months 1 to 6),

the identification of four case studies for the development of the empirical research, selecting among cultural destinations in the Veneto region, with a comparative design - e.g. two tousti-led cultural destinations and two community-led ones (months 6 to 9);

qualitative data collection and analysis through fieldwork (months 9 to 15);

a report outlining the methodology and resources needed to promote a more authentic and engaging experience in cultural destinations (months 16 to 20);

focus groups and workshops for the presentation and discussion of the research results with experts and local stakeholders in and around the selected case studies (months 20 to 24);

a research paper based on the results of the fieldwork and the empirical analysis of the processes activated with iNest funding (months 16-24)

The activity of the researcher will be monitored regularly in accordance with the formal reporting tools of the iNest project. Informal monitoring will be conducted by the supervisor during the joint undertaking of research activity and by the project leader through the verification of the regular attendance to and reporting during project meetings

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.









Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a master's degree or equivalent title obtained abroad and a professional scientific curriculum suitable for carrying out research activities

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. - the PhD;

- specialization diplomas and certificates of attendance at postgraduate specialization courses, obtained both in Italy and abroad; the performance of documented research activities carried out with public and private entities both in Italy and abroad;
- Prior post-lauream research experience;
- Competences and experiences in the domain of qualitative social research;
- Experiences in the interaction with and analysis of cultural organizations, SMEs, policymakers, and other players of cultural destinations.

Duration of contract: 24 months (approximately starting in February 2023)

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 21.401,93 Euros per year, gross percipient net of charges to be borne by the institution.

Deadline for submission of applications: january 09, 2023, 12.00 noon CET.

How to apply:

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

For qualifications and publications, from 0 up to 60 points (42 points is the minimum score for admission to the interview)

For the interview, from 0 up to 40 points (28 point is the minimum score for passing the interview)

Selection procedure

Interviews will take place on January 19, 2023.

The list of candidates admitted to the interview, the timetable, the venue of the interview, together with notice of any postponements, or changes in the time of the interview, will be announced on **January 12, 2023**, by means of a notice that will be published at the following <u>link</u>. It is the candidate's responsibility to check the admission results and, if admitted, to show up at the required date and time.

The interview may ascertain knowledge of the following topic:

- Tourism and cultural destinations
- Cultural and creative management
- Qualitative research designs and methodologies
