Research fellowship "Craft in Europe between conservation and innovation" *Project acronym:* HEPHAESTUS Heritage in EuroPe: new techHologies in crAft for prEserving and innovaTing fUtureS - CUP H73C22001530006 - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (Italian law 30 December 2010, n.240, art. 22).

Description

The Department of Management at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites application for one-year fellowship in **Craft in Europe between conservation and innovation**, under the supervision of prof. Fabrizio Panozzo (SSD SECS-P/07 (Business Administration and Accounting Studies).

Abstract: The research fellow will be integrated, also with project management roles, in the European Horizon project "Heritage in Europe: new technologies in craft for preserving and innovating future (HEPHAESTUS". The project tackles the challenges posed to the traditional craftsmanship from global markets, technological changes, and digital technologies. The research fellow will be required to participate in the analysis and mapping of the threats and opportunities facing artisan companies with particular attention to the valorization of artisan knowledge in open archives and its mobilization to innovate relations with local communities. Specific objectives of the research are: (1) to revive and enhance traditional crafts by combining them with new and emerging technologies through innovative business models for the growth of the craft sector; (2) create an craft technology-led methodology to bring together traditional know-how with new cutting-edge technologies, circular economy and New Bauhaus principles to innovate craft processes in a sustainable way; (3) explore visions for the role of crafts in the future, integrating emerging technologies and contributing to the circular economy, engaging craft communities in a participatory ideation process; (4) develop courses, programs, study programs, entrepreneurial and organizational skillsets to relaunch the encounter between craft tradition and innovation; (5) collaborate in establishing action-oriented living labs for circular craft-driven design innovation (6) and establish sustainable craft-technology relationships by linking research and heritage sites, culture and creative sectors, institutions, universities and other research institutes, regional and national authorities, companies and other interested parties. Results will include:

- a review of the literature on the business models of craft companies
- a research document outlining the state of the art of the relationship between crafts and cultural producers in the project areas
- the organization of co-creation workshops involving craft companies, local communities and cultural producers
- a report outlining the methodology for promoting innovative partnerships with craft companies, tourism, and local development
- a research document based on the results of the field work and on the empirical analysis of the activated processes.

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a master's degree Economics, Management and scientific-professional curriculum suitable to the development of research activities related to the fellowship.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.



Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: June 2023).

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to **21.888,00** *Euros* per year, including taxes and social charges depending on applicant's filing status (cost to Ca' Foscari: € 27.000,00).

Deadline for submission of applications: May 09th 2023, 12 noon (Italian time).

How to apply:

Candidates shall submit:

- 1. The application form;
- 2. A motivation letter (max 1 page) along with their CV in European format, duly dated and signed, both to enclosed as a one single.pdf file (link); a declaration must be appended in the footnote of the curriculum, pursuant to the Italian DPR 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, that the information provided corresponds to the truth. Moreover the candidates have to consent to the use of their personal data for the purposes of this selection procedure pursuant to the Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003 and to the EU Regulations 2016/679;
- 3. The attachments called "obligations and understanding" and "participation and compatibility";
- 4. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice link);
- 5. A copy of a valid identity document (either Identity Card or Passport);
