Description

Abstract: The post is related to the 2022 PRIN project Film Base Matters and the successful candidate will partake and support the activities of the Venice research unit. S/he will contribute in cutting-edge research in the area of media archaeology, focussing on the study of film's physical dimensions with an emphasis on format as a concept at the intersection of material culture, visual culture, social and cultural determinations. S/he will carry out theoretical, methodological and practical work with substandard formats by participating in the design and delivery of workshop and lab activities involving students and the citizenship alike. A background in media archaeology and experimental film is essential, while some knowledge of visual cultures is a plus. The candidate will need to be able to work in a team and to have project management skills. English language is also needed, as part of the activities will have an international outreach. Previous experience with hands-on sessions, practice-based research and (analogue) media art practice will be a plus.

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a PhD in Cinema or Media studies, or related disciplines.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.



Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19.367,00 Euros per year, including taxes and social charges.
