Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: "INTEGRATION_INTEllectual miGRATION: circulation of philosophical books and ideas around the ancient Mediterranean through the evidence of Graeco-Roman papyri: digital editions and metadata of philosophical papyri", Academic discipline: L-ANT/05 - Papyrology, duration 12 months, tutor Prof. Holger Marc ESSLER, financed by the PRIN 2022 project "INTEGRATION_INTEllectual miGRATION: circulation of philosophical books and ideas around the ancient Mediterranean through the evidence of Graeco-Roman papyri" (project code 2022SW5X3C), CUP: H53D23007110006, Head of Unit Prof. Holger Marc ESSLER.

Abstract: The project INTEGRATION aims at enriching our knowledge of Ancient Greek and Roman philosophical thought with an in-depth and multifaceted study of its circulation around the Mediterranean area through the evidence of Greco-Roman papyri. It aims at (a) the revision of published philosophical papyri, and the study of unpublished ones in view of their edition; (b) related interpretative and philosophical studies; (c) the creation of a web-based database. The temporary fellow will engage in own digital content creation by entering texts and metadata directly in the papyrological editor (papyri.info), as well as in the revision and correction of material produced by others. Further tasks include supporting the organization of the workshops on text-digitization and collaborating on the transfer of data to the new INTEGRATION platform.

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Ca' Foscari University of Venice.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a master's degree (or equivalent) in the field of Classics and a suitable scientific / professional track record.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Evaluation

research grants, study grants or assignments both in Italy and abroad;

- b) list of scientific publications;
- c) electronic submission of a maximum of 5 publications (in PDF format) to be evaluated by the Committee in charge
- d) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them see Article 5 of the competition available in Italian (link);
- e) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5 of the competition available in Italian (link).

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- Knowledge of the main research tools related to philosophical papyri;
- Disciplinary skills in the areas of expertise related to the project;
