Research fellowship on "Networks and resilience: the case of Italian network contracts" - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (Italian law 30 December 2010, n. 240, art. 22 and subsequent amendments and additions).

Description

The Department of Management at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites application for one-year fellowship in **Networks and resilience: the case of Italian network contracts,** under the supervision of prof. Anna Cabigiosu (SSD SECS-P/08 - Management)

Project acronym: PRIN 2022 "Organizing for resilience: how do networks and firms face adversities?" n. 2022RPXNJB – CUP H53D23003380006.

A full copy of the approved project will be provided to the selected applicant.

Abstract: Companies are becoming more and more exposed to shocks, adversities and unexpected events. This goes hand in hand with the increasing attention that resilience is gaining in business and management research. Notwithstanding past research has mostly focused on resilience at individual and organizational level (Hilmann & Guenther, 2021), overlooking "how inter-organizational structures should be designed for resilience" (Linnenluecke 2017: 25). As a consequence we know little about networks' characteristics and mechanisms for facing crises and adversities, also because network studies have not yet explored the role of resilience as a possible performance outcome of inter-organizational relationships (Moretti 2017). Addressing these limitations, the research will use data of the Osservatorio Nazionale sulle Reti d'Impresa (henceforth Osservatorio) to analyze the resilience of these networks and identify the structural and organizational characteristics of most resilient networks.

The research may be carried out in Italian end English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a master's degree and scientific-professional curriculum suitable to the development of research activities related to the fellowship.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: November 2023), with the possibility of renewal within the limits of art. 2 of the Regulations on university research fellowship awarding, which will be subject to a specific contract.

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to **19.456,00** *Euros* per year, including taxes and social charges depending on applicant's filing status (cost to Ca' Foscari € 24.000,00).

Deadline for submission of applications: October 24th 2023, 12 noon (Italian time).

How to apply:

Candidates shall submit:

A motivation letter (max 1 page) along with their CV in European format, duly dated and signed, both to enclosed as a one single.pdf file (<u>link</u>); a declaration must be appended in the footnote of the curriculum, pursuant to the Italian DPR 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, that the information provided corresponds to the truth. Moreover the candidates have to consent to the use of their personal data for the purposes of this selection procedure pursuant to the Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003 and to the EU Regulations 2016/679;
- 3. The attachments called "obligations and understanding" and "participation and compatibility";
- 4. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice link);
- 5. A copy of a valid identity document (either Identity Card or Passport);

The evaluation takes into account the criteria and thresholds described in the table below.
