Application Procedure	Admission  1) Students need to apply online via the portal KLIPS 2.0. Detailed instructions on the application procedure will be sent out via e-mail beforehand.  2) After completing the online application, students need to download and sign the Application for admission form and send it via e-mail to erasmus students@verw.uni-koeln.de.  Students will be informed via e-mail as soon as they have been admitted. The Letter of Admission can be printed out from KLIPS 2.0 if needed. 	Enrolment After being admitted, students are required to  1) pay the student welfare contribution by bank transfer (prerequisite for course registration; includes public transportation ticket)  2) upload a portrait photo for their student ID  3) request electronic reporting of their health insurance status from a German statutory health insurance provider and  4) download, sign and re-upload the application for enrolment.  5) After completing these steps, students will get a PIN number to activate their student account (Smail).
