The Italian Aerosol Society (IAS) with the collaboration of Ca' Foscari University of Venice will organize the third edition of IAS school. The School is addressed to PhD students, postdoctoral researchers and technician who operate in the aerosol science.

During 5 days (36 hours of lessons), students will be introduced to the most relevant aspects of aerosol properties and experimental methods with a special focus on those specifically used in climate studies. A module of the school will be also devoted to environmental impact assessment and economical aspects of climate change.

The official language of the school will be English.

APPLICATION AND LOGISTICS

The participation to the School is limited: the first 35 applications will be accepted. Requests will not be considered for participation limited to a few days. The registration fee includes an "all inclusive" treatment (registration, accommodation, meals from Sunday to Friday, June 19-23). The travelling costs to Venice are borne by the participants. Applications must be Carole Lecerf sent bv email (c.lecerf@isac.cnr.it) specifying educational qualification, employment accommodation in a double or single, and any special requests (e.g. preferences for placement in double room). After receiving confirmation, the registration must be completed by April 21, 2017 with payment of the participation fee by bank IAS transfer account at the Banca Prossima spa, Milano IBAN: IT36Z0335901600100000003937.

Upon receipt of the bank transfer, the participants will receive by email a final confirmation of registration and information about the accommodations. The invoice for the payment will be delivered directly in Venice, any
