Research fellowship on 'The Emergence of New Industry Architectures for Sustainable Mobility (NASM)' - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (Italian law 30 December 2010, n.240, art. 22)

Description

The Department of Management at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for a fellowship in "The Emergence of New Industry Architectures for Sustainable Mobility (NASM)" – CUP H74I19001400005, under the supervision of prof. Francesco Zirpoli.

The research shall be carried out English. The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Abstract: The project will investigate how and to what extent the diffusion and introduction of sustainable mobility technologies will result in a new business ecosystem and how this will impact on the articulation of the industry in terms of product architectures and division of labor within the value chain. The project will serve as a pilot study for an international comparative research. Starting from the systematic reconstruction of different technological scenarios, the project will focus on an accurate analysis of opportunities and threats for the various players currently operating in the car industry, and of how the emergence of technologies alternative to internal combustion engine can impact on the structure of the automotive supply chain. Leveraging on a Center for Automotive and Mobility Innovation (www.unive.it/cami) proprietary dataset of Italian suppliers, the research will map the current product/competence against the new industry and product architecture following the introduction of hybrid and electric powertrain. An assessment of the creation/loss of jobs will be made as well as a mapping of the technologies on which suppliers operating in Italy lack the necessary know-how.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold doctoral degree in Management and relevant experience on the research topic and scientific-professional curriculum suitable to the development of research activities related to the fellowship.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: April 2020).

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19.367,00 *Euros* per year, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: March 23th 2020, 12 noon (Italian time).

Evaluation

The total mark of each candidate will be awarded based on 100 total points. The evaluation takes into account the criteria and thresholds described in the table below.
