Research fellowship on "Vulnerability in international protection regimes. The issue of human trafficking" - Ca' Foscari University Venice

Description

The Department of Philosophy and Cultural Heritage at Ca' Foscari University Venice invites applications for a fellowship in:

Title: Vulnerability in international protection regimes. The issue of human trafficking.

Scientific Disciplinary Sectors and/or Competition Sector Groups: SPS/08-Sociology of culture and communication

Scientific Responsible tutor: prof. Sabrina Marchetti

Duration: 12 months (renewable)

Abstract: The research is part of the HORIZON2020-MIGRATION-07-2019 project "*VULNER: Vulnerabilities under the global protection regime: how does the law assess, address, shape, and produce the vulnerabilities of protection seekers?*" The aim of the project is a critical analysis of the concept of vulnerability, of the meaning and practices associated with it from the social, political and legal point of view. The VULNER research will focus on the case of "protection seekers" in Belgium, Germany, Italy, Norway, Canada, Lebanon, Uganda and South Africa.

The fellowship research fulfils Work Package 10 of the project, concerning the issue of trafficking for all the countries involved in the project. The research entails gathering materials prepared by the national teams for their countries, and providing an interpretative analysis of such collection of data. It will be particularly relevant to look at it in a gender and intersectional perspective. Essential to the research is also the dissemination of project's results to specialist and non-specialist audiences, including policy-makers and stakeholders, in collaboration with the rest of the Italian team (Work Package 4).

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a PhD in the social sciences field.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: 1st of May 2020).

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to Euro 35,150.00 per year, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: April 6th, 2020 12.00 noon (Italian time).

How to apply:

Candidates should submit:

- 1. The application form;
- 2. A motivation letter (max 1 page) along with their CV in European format, duly dated and signed,



both to enclosed as a one single.pdf file (<u>link</u>);

- 3. A copy of a valid identity document (either Identity Card or Passport);
- 4. (If available) Evaluation Summary Reports of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions Individual Fellowships/ ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) individual proposals having passed all the evaluation thresholds;
- 5. (If available) Details of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions Individual Fellowships, ERC Starting Grants, FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/ SIR Scientific Young Independence Research funded projects within the call deadline;
- 6. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice <u>link</u>).

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically: For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60; For interview, from 0 to 40.

Selection procedure

Short-listed candidates will be invited for interview on the **17th of April 2020** at **9.00 a.m. (Italian time)**. The short-list of the candidates admitted to the interview, or any postponement, will be published on the University's webpage on the **10th of April 2020** (link).
