Research fellowship MIMOSA – Maritime and Multimodal Sustainable Passenger Transport Solutions and Services – Italy Croatia Passengers Behavioural Analysis - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (Italian law 30 December 2010, n.240, art. 22)

Description

The Department of Management at University Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for two-year post-doc fellowship in: MIMOSA – Maritime and Multimodal Sustainable Passenger Transport Solutions and Services – Italy Croatia Passengers Behavioural Analysis - Interreg Project Italia-Croazia 2014-2020 - CUP E89E20000780005, under the supervision of prof. Pietro Lanzini - SECS-P/08 (Management).

Reference to project Work Packages: WP3.1, WP4.5, WP5.1, WP5.2, WP5.3, WP6.1, WP6.2.

A full copy of the approved project will be provided to the selected applicant.

Abstract:

The research will be carried out in English. This research grant is one (of four) that are part of the MIMOSA (INTERREG ITA-CRO CBC Program) project, aimed at Increasing the knowledge of transport demand and, specifically, of passenger behaviour in the programme area (Croatia and coastal regions of Italy). The specific objective of this grant is twofold: a) to improve the knowledge of passengers' needs and behavior, b) understanding passengers' attitudes towards sustainable transport solutions. Through data collection, targeted interviews and questionnaires, the selected applicant will have to provide both descriptive and inferential analyses about behavioral and psychological determinants of travel choices (e.g., attitudes, values, habits, behavioral control) in the specific context of the MIMOSA project. Research results are intended to enhance the capability of public authorities to orient people behaviors towards the use of multi-modal sustainable mobility solutions at the expense of private cars.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold master's degree in Economics, management, statistics, engineering, mathematical, physical and natural sciences and a scientific-professional curriculum suitable to the development of research activities related to the fellowship.

The knowledge of the Croatian language, although not necessary, is highly appreciated.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 24 months (approximately starting: September/October 2020).

Gross salary: the research fellowship amounts to 20.000,00 Euros per year, including taxes depending on applicant's filing status (cost to Ca' Foscari: € 24.564,00).

Deadline for submission of applications: August 24th 2020, 12 noon (CE time).
