

Research fellowship on "The glocalization of East Asian religions: interculturality, hybridity and bricolage among youth in Italy" - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia

Description

The Department of Asian and North African Studies at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for a fellowship in:

Title: The glocalization of East Asian religions: interculturality, hybridity and bricolage among youth in Italy

Scientific sector: L-OR/20

Scientific supervisor and tutor: Prof. Toshio Miyake

Duration: 12 mesi

Abstract: The research project aims at analyzing glocalization of East Asian religions in the context of contemporary Italy. In particular, it will identify the diffusion, perception and appropriation among school-age youth of a wide range of phenomena: from the more consolidated presence of foreign branches of institutional traditions, to the emergence of New Religious Movements and of religious-individual bricolage, as well as the more transversal consumption of elements related to East Asian religions as they are represented in popular media (movies, video games, internet, etc.). The investigation will employ methods such as questionnaires, focus groups and action-research. It will consider closely the interactions between school and extra-school environment, in the wake of studies on the everyday experiences and knowledge of learners. Particular attention will be paid to the relational dynamics between hetero-representations of East Asian religious diversity and self-representations of youth identity, referring to concepts of hybridity, contact zone, occcidentalism, orientalism and auto-orientalism. The broader purpose is to identify the potentialities emerging from the glocalization of East Asian religions in the perspective of an intercultural education suitable to the new processes of communication and socialization in Italy and Europe.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a doctoral degree.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: June, 01, 2021).

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19,367 Euros per year, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: May, 12, 12.00 noon.

How to apply:

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically: For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60; For interview, from 0 to 40.

Selection procedure

Short-listed candidates will be invited for interview on May, 20, 2021 at 10 AM via Zoom videoconference
