Research fellowship on Special Projects - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (Italian law 30 December 2010, n.240, art. 22)

Description

The Department of Linguistic and Comparative Cultural studies at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for a fellowship in:

Title: Promoting pluriliteracies in the secondary English classroom through the production of digital narratives on global issues

Scientific area: L-LIN/02

Abstract:

The post-doc fellowship is related to the Erasmus + (KA2) project entitled "Lit. Up Your Phones: A Digital Toolkit for ESL/EFL Classroom to Combat Social Inequalities in Times of Covid19 Crises". The research conducted during the fellowship will focus on Work Packages O1 (A3, A5, A6), O2 (A1, A3 e A4) and O3 (A1 e A2), through the study of the theoretical and practical approaches which can inform students' production of digital stories in English as a FL starting from their comprehension of literary texts which deal with global issues (e.g., gender equality, disability, climate change, etc.). Specifically, the post-doc fellow will have to:

a. define, together with the other partners, a teaching model to guide English teachers to support students' production of digital stories. Starting from the exploration of the different models aimed at the promotion of students' pluriliteracies in the English classroom, the research fellow will contribute to the construction of a model based on students' critical and creative comprehension of literary texts of different nature (novels, poems, short stories etc.) and on their use of different digital strategies and tools to produce a digital story.

b. write, together with the other partners, a student guide on digital storytelling, starting from the study of the different processes of digital storytelling and of the affordances of this method for language teaching;

c. contribute to create, experiment, and evaluate, together with the partner school, learning activities based on the model (see "a") with the aim of producing digital stories in English as a FL which will be uploaded on the project webpage;

d. participate in the dissemination activities of the project (scientific publications and seminars).

The call aims at finding a candidate with the scientific and professional requirements necessary to fulfil the activities described above.



Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a doctoral degree in the area Glottology and Linguistics and a scientific-professional curriculum suitable for carrying out research activities.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: March 2022).

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19.367 Euros per year, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: 29/01/2022, 12.00 noon.

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically: For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60; For interview, from 0 to 40.
