Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: "Historical-linguistic study of the theories of Atticist lexica", Academic discipline: L-FIL-LET/02 Greek Language and Literature, Tutor prof.ssa Olga Tribulato, within the ERC-2019-Consolidator Grant Project entitled "PURA - Purism in Antiquity: Theories of Language in Greek Atticist Lexica and their Legacy", Grant Agreement n. 865817, CUP: H72F20000150006.

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Abstract

The research is aimed at the historical-linguistic analysis of a group of entries in Atticist lexica, useful for reconstructing the theories of Atticism on the evolution of the phonology, morphology (nominal and verbal) and syntax of Greek between the classical and imperial ages. The materials analyzed in this research project will form the basis for the broader study of the linguistic theories of Atticism hosted in the monograph produced by the PURA team.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a PhD in Classics with a focus on language and philology, and an appropriate academic and professional CV with at least 2 years of adeguate research experience at post-doctoral level.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: 1st September 2022).

Stipend: The research fellowship total amount is 28.373,78 Euros, including taxes and social charges.

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

- For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60;
- For the interview, from 0 to 40.

Candidates are admitted to the interview if assessment of the qualifications and the possible tests results in a score equal to or greater than 42/60.

The following qualifications are considered as evaluation criteria:

- a) a list of the candidate's scientific publications and evidence of research interests in the following fields:
- 1. history of the Greek language, linguistic analysis of ancient Greek phonology and morphology, linguistic analysis of Greek literary texts and local dialects;
- 2. Greek lexicography and its contribution to the study of the Greek language;
- b) attendance certificates (or diplomas) of post-graduate specialization courses, obtained both in Italy and abroad; contracts, scholarships or assignments of research activities in public and private entities both in Italy and abroad;
- d) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them see Article 5;
- e) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5.

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- competence in the history of the Greek language and the historical-linguistic methodologies applied to the study of the phonology and morphology of Greek, as well as its literary languages and dialects:
- competence in Greek lexicography: ability to interpret the lemmas of the lexica and the critical systems of the main critical editions.

At the end of his/her research activity, the research fellow is required to provide the Department with:

- Ca. 40 lexicographic studies, according to the model already developed by the project for its Digital Encyclopedia of Atticism. Each study will be devoted to the main phonological and morphological features discussed in Atticist lexica;
- A survey of Philemon's lexicon, aimed at identifying useful entries for the historical-linguistic study of Atticist theories.

Selection procedure

The interview will be held on **30**th **June 2022**, **h. 9.30 a.m.** The interview will be held in remote (with Zoom). The short-list of the candidates admitted to the interview, or any postponement, will be published on the University's webpage on **23**rd **June 2022** (<u>link</u>).
