Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: “**Development of a model for describing collections and documents of historical-artistic and literary heritage and its integration with the services provided by ILC4CLARIN**”, Academic discipline: INF/01 Informatics (principal), L-ART/04 Museology, art and restoration criticism, L-LIN/01 Glottology and linguistics, L-FIL-LET/08 Medieval and humanistic latin literature, tutor dr. Stefania De Vincentis, co-tutor prof. Franz Fischer, dr. Federico Boschetti (CNR-ILC), prof. Monica Monachini (CNR-ILC).

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Abstract

The research project involves the study of a digital model for describing historical, artistic, and literary heritage collections and records. The pilot phase will cover the following areas:

- the design of a descriptive model of digitized images within both museum and archive collections using applications of the IIF framework;
- the collaboration in developing new features for the management of digital philology projects to be implemented on the ILC4CLARIN' server;
- research dissemination activities such as seminars and workshops in collaboration with VeDPH and CNR-ILC at the CLARIN Knowledge Centre (DiPText-KC);
- support of the teaching activities and internships of the Master Degree in Digital and Public Humanities.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a Master Degree in Computer Science (23/S, LM18), Computer Engineering (35/S, LM32), Digital Humanities (24/S, LM43) or equivalent and an appropriate academic and professional CV.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximately starting: 1st October 2022).

Stipend: The research fellowship total amount is **19.367,00** Euros, including taxes and social charges.



Deadline for submission of applications: 22nd September 2022, h. 12.00 noon (Italian time)

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

- For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60;
- For the interview, from 0 to 40.

Candidates are admitted to the interview if assessment of the qualifications and the possible tests results in a score equal to or greater than 42/60.

The following qualifications are considered as evaluation criteria:

- a) a list of the candidate's scientific publications;
- b) specialisation diplomas and attendance certificates at post-graduate specialisation courses, obtained both in Italy or abroad, documented research activity in public and private organisations with contracts, study grants or assignments both in Italy and abroad;
- c) Training and teaching activities;

d) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them - see Article 5 of the competition available in Italian ([link](#));

e) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5 of the competition available in Italian ([link](#)).

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- Excellent knowledge of programming and markup languages such as Python, C/C++, Java, JavaScript, XML, XSL(T), XQuery, HTML, CSS;
- Skills of the IIIF framework;
- Knowledge of Handwriting Text Recognition (HTR) and/or Optical Character Recognition (OCR) technologies;
- Good knowledge of English.

At the end of his/her research activity, the research fellow is required to provide the Department with:

- Development of a model for a IIIF manifest to be adapted to the museum collections of the Borghese Gallery in Rome and to digital textual editions;
- A scientific paper on the IIIF framework for digital museum and text collections, within one year of the end of the research grant and initial approvals by the tutors;
- Production of dissemination and scientific material to be published on the DiPText-KC website.

Selection procedure

The interview will be held on **27th September 2022, h. 2 p.m.** The interview will be held in remote (with Zoom).
