Research fellowship on "New digital critical edition of Ausonius' poems", tutor prof. Luca Mondin and prof. Martina Chiara Venuti, Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Italian law 30 December 2010, n. 240, art. 22)

## Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: "New digital critical edition of **Ausonius' poetic poems**", Academic discipline: L-FIL-LET/04 Latin language and literature, tutor prof. Luca Mondin, co-tutor prof. Martina Chiara Venuti.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

#### Abstract

Ausonius is an author with a varied poetic production, highly representative of the cultural facies of Roman Gaul in the 4th century and of the trends of Late Latin poetry as a whole. The complicated tradition of hic poetical works has been studied by a large number of both general and partial studies in recent years. For this reason, a new digital edition of Ausonius' poetical works on the MQDQ archive is needed (https://mizar.unive.it/mqdq/public/indici/autori/idAuthors/183). It will include: I) a new critical text based on the editions by R.P.H. Green (Oxford 1991 and 1999) revised according to the studies and editions of the last 25 years; II) an apparatus of variants created ex novo according to the methodological criteria of MQDQ on the basis of the critical apparatus of the scholarly editions from K. Schenkl (1883) to the present day and of the checking of the manuscript and printed tradition, with relative updating in the description of the witnesses; III) the metrical mark-up of the texts in nondactylic metre.

## Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold:

- PhD in Latin Philology, Classical Philology, Classics or similar, obtained with a thesis on scientific topics of the Italian s.s.d. L-FIL-LET/04 Latin language and literature and appropriate academic and professional CV.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. ## How to apply

Candidates should submit:

- 1. The application form;
- 2. A motivation letter (max 1 page) along with their CV in European format, duly dated and signed, both to enclosed as a one single.pdf file (<u>link</u>);
- 3. A copy of a valid identity document (either Identity Card or Passport);
- 4. (If available) Evaluation Summary Reports of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions Individual Fellowships/ ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) individual proposals having passed all the evaluation thresholds;
- (If available) Details of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions Individual Fellowships, ERC Starting Grants, FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/ SIR Scientific Young Independence Research funded projects;
- 6. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice <u>link</u>);

## Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

- For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60;

- For the interview, from 0 to 40.

Candidates are admitted to the interview if assessment of the qualifications and the possible tests results in a score equal to or greater than 42/60.

The following qualifications are considered as evaluation criteria:

a) a list of the candidate's scientific publications, including the doctoral thesis;

b) specialisation diplomas and attendance certificates at post-graduate specialisation courses, obtained both in Italy or abroad;

c) documented research activity in public and private organisations with contracts, study grants or assignments both in Italy and abroad, related to projects or work on digital editions or digital philology at a scientific level;

d) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them - see Article 5 of the competition available in Italian (<u>link</u>);

e) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5 of the competition available in Italian (link).

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- a good knowledge of Ausonius' works, their manuscript tradition and the related problems;
- a good knowledge of MQDQ (<u>https://mizar.unive.it/mqdq/</u>) and its tools;
- knowledge of English language.

At the end of his/her research activity, the research fellow is required to provide the Department with:

- a new digital edition of the works of Ausonius in MQDQ with an index of manuscript and printed sources and an apparatus of textual variants;
- a seminar or a conference paper and an article in a scholarly journal on the achieved experience and the current state of criticism of Ausonius' text.

#### Selection procedure

The interview will be on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2023, 10.30 a.m., at the Department of Humanities, Palazzo Malcanton Marcorà, Office C12 (first floor), Dorsoduro 3484/D, Venice.
