Research fellowship on Motivations, experiences and consequences of returns and readmissions policy: revealing and developing effective alternatives - Università Ca' Foscari Venezia

Description

The Department Philosophy and Cultural Heritage at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for a fellowship in:

Title: Return and readmission of migrants: analysis of return and readmission policies, their consequences and public discourses; the experiences of migrants and the alternatives.

SSD: SPS/07

Abstract: MORE project (Horizon Europe Program) aims to provide an updated knowledge and a critical analysis regarding Return and Readmission (RR) policies, at EU and national level, through the inclusion of perspectives and experiences of the subjects who are affected by such migration policy – primarily undocumented migrants. To this end, MORE studies the logic and the discourses that led to the development of a RR policy, clarifies what RR practices concretely consist, examines the consequences of RR on undocumented migrants and on society in general. Through qualitative research in 13 countries (EU and non-EU), MORE provides an in-depth assessment of the results and effects of RR policies and practices. Furthermore, it suggests alternative approaches to RR, also through the mapping and analysis of experiences and practices (at local, national, transnational level) which provide support to migrants in accessing services and rights.

The research fellow will participate in the following activities of the first year of the project:

1. in-depth, systematic and multilevel (EU, Member States) analysis of the development of RR policy;
2. analysis of alternatives for third-country nationals, providing a comparative picture of de facto and de jure legal statuses, practices and regularization approaches;
3. analysis of political and economic reasons, of media discourses, concerning RR.

Within MORE, University of Venice carry out the study on the Italian national context. The research fellow will participate in project meetings that will take place in Italy or abroad, and will contribute to the writing of the reports.

The research will be carried out mainly in Italian; some parts may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a doctoral degree in social science and related subjects.



Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months, possibility of renewal (approximately starting: May 1st, 2023).

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19.367,00 Euros per year, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: February, 24, 2023 – 12.00 noon (Italian time)

How to apply:

Candidates should submit:

1. The application form;

7. (If available) Details of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships, ERC Starting Grants, FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/ SIR Scientific Young Independence Research funded projects;
8. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice [link](#)).

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60;
