Research fellowship on "PoetRi. Female poetry of the Renaissance. Commentary on Gaspara Stampa's "Rime" - Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Italian law 30 December 2010, n. 240, art. 22 and subsequent amendments and additions)

Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: **PoetRi. Female poetry of the Renaissance. Commentary on Gaspara Stampa's "Rime"**, Academic discipline: L-FIL-LET/10 - Italian literature, duration 12 months, tutor Prof. Elisa CURTI, financed by the PRIN 2022 project "PoetRi. Female poetry of the Renaissance" (project code 2022CWL4H2), CUP: H53D23006820006, Head of Unit Prof. Elisa CURTI.

Abstract: The research concerns the female poetic experience in the Veneto area. Specifically, the assignee will focus on the rhymes of Gaspara Stampa, whose structure and ordering are burdened with doubts and much discussed by recent critics. The aim will be to procure a new and more in-depth commentary than the one available so far (Ceriello 2002). The focus will be as much on the textual and intertextual dimension as on the reflection on the intellectual relations that La Stampa entertained with the poets her contemporaries, the most famous being Pietro Bembo. This last element will make it possible to illuminate - even if only by probing - some passages of one of the most fertile lyric seasons of our tradition, stimulating, in perspective, further studies on the lesser-known, but very widespread female poetry of the Veneto environment (think of poets such as Veronica Franco, Isabella Andreini, Maddalena Campiglia and Lucrezia Marinelli).

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Ca' Foscari University of Venice.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a PhD (or equivalent qualification) and a suitable scientific / professional track record.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 months (approximate starting date: 1st January 2024)

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19,367 Euros, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: 7th November 2023, h. 12.00 noon (Italian time).

How to apply:

Candidates shall submit:

curriculum, pursuant to the Italian DPR 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, that the information provided corresponds to the truth. Moreover the candidates have to consent to the use of their personal data for the purposes of this selection procedure pursuant to the Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003 and to the EU Regulations 2016/679;

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically: For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60; For interview, from 0 to 40.

The following qualifications are considered as evaluation criteria:

- a) list of publications;
- b) specialisation diplomas and certificates of attendance at postgraduate specialisation courses, obtained both in Italy and abroad, the performance of documented research activities at public and private entities with contracts, research grants, scholarships or assignments both in Italy and abroad;
- c) documented experience in commenting on Renaissance poetic texts (with particular focus on female poetry).

- d) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them see Article 5 of the competition available in Italian (link);
- e) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5 of the competition available in Italian (link).

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- Skills in exegesis of Renaissance lyric texts
- Specific knowledge of Renaissance women's literature
- Editorial practice skills
- Knowledge of the English language

At the end of his/her research activity, the research fellow is required to provide the Department with:

- Preparing a complete commentary on the Rime of Gaspara Stampa
