Research fellowship on "The impact of investments in culture between enterprises and civil society. A comparative analysis of corporate strategies and foundations' policies in a social accountability perspective" Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (Italian law 30 December 2010, n. 240, art. 22 and subsequent amendments and additions).

# Description

The Department of Management at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites application for one-year fellowship in *The impact of investments in culture between enterprises and civil society. A comparative analysis of corporate strategies and foundations' policies in a social accountability perspective*, under the supervision of prof. Fabrizio Panozzo (SSD ECON-06/A Business Administration, Accounting & Performance Measurement).

**Abstract**: The research aims to produce a deeper knowledge of the use of performance indicators within interventions in support of culture by enterprises and private institutions, analysing their approach to measurement in two specular contexts: banking foundations and enterprises with a distinct policy of supporting cultural production. Through the use of a historical perspective, though one extended up to the present, the project endeavours to reconstruct intentions, processes and results of the private sector's support of culture by reading these elements through the lens of the accounting instruments developed and introduced to represent and govern complex phenomena such as wellbeing, development, knowledge, reputation and philanthropy. The category of "impact" appears as the point of convergence of many of these efforts, and as such, it is upon this that the research proposes to focus.

In particular, the project establishes the following objectives:

- Contextualisation of the growing interest in the cultural sector within a wider preoccupation for the social impact of enterprises;
- Historic and geographically situated in-depth study of the role of banking foundations as actors historically linked to interventions in the social sector and, more specifically, in the cultural one.
- Reconstruction of the paths through which traditional enterprises come into contact with culture and of the approaches selected to measure their contribution to that field.

Comparative analysis of the approaches to support the cultural sector and the accountability logics of foundations and enterprises, considering also the effects on the benefitting cultural organisations

The research may be carried out in Italian and English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

#### Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a master's degree in LM-76 (Economic Sciences for Environment and Culture) or LM-77 (Economic and business sciences) and scientific-professional curriculum suitable to the development of research activities related to the fellowship.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

**Duration of contract:** 12 months (approximately starting: September 2024), with the possibility of renewal within the limits of art. 2 of the Regulations on university research fellowship awarding, which will be subject to



a specific contract.

**Stipend**: The research fellowship amounts to **19.367,00** *Euros per year*, including taxes and social charges depending on applicant's filing status (cost to Ca' Foscari € 24.000,00).

# How to apply:

Candidates shall submit:

A motivation letter (max 1 page) along with their CV in European format, duly dated and signed, both to enclosed as a one single.pdf file (<u>link</u>); a declaration must be appended in the footnote of the curriculum, pursuant to the Italian DPR 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, that the information provided corresponds to the truth. Moreover the candidates have to consent to the use of their personal data for the purposes of this selection procedure pursuant to the Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003 and to the EU Regulations 2016/679;

- All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice link);
