Description

The Department of Humanities at Ca' Foscari University of Venice (Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia) invites applications for a fellowship in: "Lexicon and textual functions of academic Italian" - LIFI-01/A Italian Linguistics, Cod. GSD 10/LIFI-01 (vd. DM 639/2024), duration 12 months, tutor prof. Davide MASTRANTONIO, financed by PRIN 2022 PNRR- Missione 4 "Istruzione e Ricerca" del Piano Nazionale di Ripresa e Resilienza ed in particolare la componente C2 – investimento 1.1, Fondo per il Programma Nazionale di Ricerca e Progetti di Rilevante Interesse Nazionale (PRIN) project: "P20222CFEE - Dizionario dell'italiano accademico: forme e funzioni testuali (DIA)", CUP: H53D23009570001, Principal Investigator prof. Davide MASTRANTONIO.

Abstract: The object of the research is to study the characteristics of academic Italian, with a focus on the relationship between lexical forms and textual functions. The research is based on a corpus of texts and involves the extraction of a list of relevant words and their corresponding functions. The study of this lexicon in a functional key is headed on the one hand to the growth of our knowledge in the field of varieties of contemporary Italian, and on the other hand to the creation of an open access digital dictionary of academic expressions which will also have didactic purposes.

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Ca' Foscari University of Venice.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a master's degree and a suitable scientific / professional track record.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar. Duration of contract: 12 months (approximate starting date: 15th November 2024)

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to 19.367,00 Euros, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: 28th October 2024, h. 12.00 noon (Italian time).

Candidates shall submit:

The candidate, after the uploading, will receive a submission number and an e-mail acknowledging receipt of his/her application.

The candidate if necessary could access the procedures for updating any data and materials by the link provided by the e-mail, in any case any updates must be made no later than the deadline on **28th October 2024**, **h. 12.00 noon (Italian time)**.

Please note that the University can be contacted for any support needs by the candidate until 25th October 2024 (h. 1 p.m. Italian time).

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically: For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 60; For interview, from 0 to 40.

The following qualifications are considered as evaluation criteria:

- a) a PhD, or the completion of a PhD course pending graduation;
- b) list of publications on research topics;
- c) electronic submission of a maximum of 3 publications (in PDF format);
- d) specialisation diplomas and attendance certificates at post-graduate specialization courses, obtained both in Italy or abroad;









- e) documented research activity in public and private organisations with contracts, study grants or assignments both in Italy and abroad;
- f) attached 'preferential securities', if the candidate possesses them see Article 5 of the competition available in Italian (link);
- g) any other element provided for the announcement, to the articles 2, 3 and 5 of the competition available in Italian (link).

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

- Experience in text analysis of contemporary non-literary Italian texts, based on the principles of text linguistics and jargons;
- Knowledge of studies related to academic register, with emphasis on Italian language;
- Assessment of English language proficiency.

At the end of his/her research activity, the research fellow is required to provide the Department with:

- active participation in the creation of the digital dictionary;
- drafting of a certain number of items of the Dictionary of academic Italian.

Selection procedure

The interview will be **on 11th November 2024, h. 09:00 a.m.** The interview will be held in remote with Google Meet.
