HAVING REGARD TO the Regional Management Decree no. 231 of 10/03/2020 and subsequent amendments and additions, which approves the research project with code 2120-0013-1463-2019, entitled "Enhancement of the terpene fraction of waste from the agri-food sector: green extractions with supercritical carbon dioxide for the formulation of nutraceutical and cosmetic products with antioxidant and anti-inflammatory activity " CUP H74I19001920002 as part of the 2019 regional call for applications - Decree of the Regional Government no. 1463/2019 - "Innovazione e ricerca per un Veneto più competitivo" (Innovation and Research to make Veneto more Competitive) - POR ESF 2014-2020 - Ob. Description

The Department of Molecolar Sciences and Nanosystems of the Ca' Foscari University of Venice, on the basis of Decree no. 178/2021 prot. n. 15785 of 04/03/2021 on the awarding of research grants for visiting fellows, hereby calls for applications for the research entitled "Comparative analysis of the extraction procedures of processing residues from the agri-food sector, specifically of fruit, horticultural and honey production, for the selective obtaining of terpenes and terpenoids with antioxidant and anti-inflammatory action" lasting 3

The Visiting Fellow must perform the following research:

the project intends to benefit from a visiting scholar in the Young Talents category, identified in a figure in possession of a master degree in Chemistry or preferably a research doctorate (PhD in chemistry already obtained or in the process of being obtained upon application) who has already acquired knowledge in the field of issues related to the enhancement of various types of biomass waste. Even more specifically, a scientific curriculum will be required that testifies to the acquisition of a research experience capable of integrating the topic of the green economy declined in the transformation of waste of renewable origin with the methods and principles of Green Chemistry and engineering. sustainable (process) chemistry. Furthermore, since this is the selection of a young scholar, the international value of the group / s who have / have supervised the training will be assessed in order to give priority, if possible, to profiles who have worked in prestigious scientific environments that are relevant in the recovery of waste biomass both for the quality of their publications and for contacts and projects with the business world of the sector in Europe and overseas. Consistent with this proposal, the visiting scholar will have to develop within the project a comparative analysis of the expected extraction procedures of agrifood processing residues and examine the sustainability of the treatments in the context of the green economy. In the period (3 months) in which he / she will be involved in the project, his / her activity will be mainly associated with that of the research fellow I, contributing to the research objectives as regards the selection and pre-treatment of residual biomasses already described elsewhere. , and the green design of their extraction with supercritical CO2. Overall, this visiting fellowship will be enhanced to encourage international scientific exchange and cooperation between the universities involved and with a view to developing new projects shared in the topic in question, but also to facilitate research through the study and analysis of good experimental practices enriched by the experiential knowledge of the RdA and UF business partners.

As stated in the ESF Directive, Decree of the Regional Government no. 1463/2019, upon completing their research, fellows must provide the department with the following research output:

- a **final report on the activities undertaken**, highlighting the results achieved.

Visiting fellows will also be required to complete a "weekly diary", recording their research activities.

Duration of the contract: 3 months, indicatively starting from April 2021

Amount: The total research grant is € 12.000,00. The amount awarded is understood to include any costs relating to the undertaking of the research envisaged by the project.

N.B. In the case of a fellowships lasting less than two or three months, the amounts will be recalculated based on the actual duration.

Deadline for the submission of applications: 24th March 2021 at 9.00 a.m. (italian time)

Who can apply? (University Regulation for short-term research fellowships, Art. 3)

The call is intended exclusively for professors/researchers from foreign universities.

Applications are open to EU citizens and non-EU citizens who hold:

a) A Bachelor's degree, Master's degree or equivalent foreign qualification in Chemistry

The requirements must be held by the deadline for this call for applications.

Candidates are admitted to the selection conditionally; they may be excluded from the call at any time should they fail to meet the predefined requirements, even after the selection process is complete, with just cause and notification sent to the person concerned.

Incompatibility (University Regulations for short-term research fellowships, Art. 12)

The grant may not be combined with:

- research grants awarded according to Law no. 240 of 30 December 2010, Art. 22 ("assegno di ricerca");
- scholarships awarded for any reason, except those awarded by national and foreign research institutes for research periods abroad as part of the specific activities stated in the programme of work carried out by the holder.

If the grant holder is also self-employed or an employee or contract worker, compatibility shall be certified by the Principal Investigator.

The awarding of the grant does not imply the establishment of any employment contract, nor does it give rise to any rights of access to positions of employment at the university.

Selection and evaluation procedures

Candidates shall be selected, on the basis of their qualifications and an interview, by a selection committee appointed pursuant to Art. 7 of the Regulation for the awarding of short-term research fellowships.

The interview will still be held on 25th March 2021 at 11.00 a.m. through Google meet

Therefore, candidates are required to present themselves, with a valid identification document, without notice, at the premises, on the days and at the time indicated in the public notice.

The absence of candidates from the interview will be considered to all intents and purposes as a renunciation of the selection, whatever the cause.

The Selection Committee awards a maximum of 100 points to applications, on the basis of the qualifications (or, alternatively, qualifications and interview), and then drafts a final merit-based ranking according to the assigned scores and identifies the winner. If the event of a tie, priority shall be granted to the younger of the two candidates.

The ranking shall be used according to the order in which it has been formulated and, in the event of withdrawal or failure by the assignee to accept the award by the deadline set by the department or early termination of the research collaboration agreement, the grant shall be assigned to another candidate following the order of the final merit-based ranking, in accordance with the Regulation for the Awarding of short-term research fellowships (Art. 8). The Selection Committee shall submit a competition report to the Director of the research department, who, after verifying the legitimacy of the competition procedure, shall approve the procedure and award the grant by Director's decree

Awarding of the grant and publication of the documents

Having received the documents relating to the selection procedure, the Department Director shall approve the ranking and the competition report by Director's decree and make them public.

The secretariat of the department that issued the call for applications shall inform the winner in writing, including the start date of the grant.

The winner must accept the grant within seven days of receipt of the written notification referred to above, under penalty of revocation. In the event of withdrawal by the assignee, the grant shall be assigned to another candidate, following the order of the final merit-based ranking.

The results of all phases of the selection process shall be published in the University's online register, on the Department web page (https://www.unive.it/data/18499/) and on the dedicated page of the University website link. Access shall nonetheless be guaranteed to the records of the selection procedure, pursuant to Italian Law no. 241 of 7 August 1990 and subsequent amendments and additions and the relative internal implementing regulation.
