

Call for application for A Research Scholarship on *Analysis of the financial criticalities of Italian municipalities* (Regulations about Short Research fellowships issued under D.R. 300/2014 of 14/04/2014 and subsequent amendments and additions)

Description

The Department of Economics at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia invites applications for six scholarships

- Title: Analysis of the financial criticalities of Italian municipalities
- **start of the programme:** The research programme envisages the start of the activity approximately in May 2024
- scientific coordinator and tutor: Prof. Stefano Campostrini
- *duration:* 8 months
- **SSD:** SECS S/05;

abstract:

The fellow will have to carry out the following research activity: analysis of the procedures of financial distress and multi-year financial rebalancing activated by the Italian municipalities and capitalization of the related results for the purpose of drawing up a possible proposal to reform the management methods of the financial criticalities of the Municipalities.

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to **17.640,00**Euros.

Minimum Application Requirements

• Master's degree in statistics - economics and Master's degree in Public Administration Sciences or similar

The requirements must be satisfied on the date of expiry of the deadline set by this call for applications.

Preferred titles

- At least ten years' research experience in the field of social - economic research applied to public spheres;

- Knowledge of the discipline of local authorities;

- Proven experience in carrying out training, research, analysis and evaluation projects and activities on the themes of this Notice on behalf of universities and/or research institutes;

- Knowledge of the Italian language (in order to be able to interact with the research team) at least C1.

Deadline for submission of applications: <u>2024-04-26, h. 12:00 noon – local time</u>

Candidates should submit:

Selection procedure

The selection is made by assessment of the scientific-professional qualifications of the candidates, the *curriculum vitae et studiorum*, the scientific publications

Incompatibility

The fellowships within this announcement may not be combined with:

- other scholarships for any reason conferred, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions useful to integrate, with stays abroad, the research activity of the scholarship holder;

- the attendance of doctorate courses with scholarship and medical specialization courses, in Italy and abroad;

- research grants;

- subordinate work relationships.

Scholarship holders may carry out occasional work activities, subject to written communication to the scientific director and on condition that: a) this activity is declared by the director compatible with the exercise of the research activity covered by the scholarship; b) it does not involve a conflict of interest with the specific research activity carried out by the scholarship holder; c) it is not prejudicial to the university, in relation to the activities carried out. The awarding of the scholarship does not give rise to the constitution of any employment relationship, nor does it give rise to rights regarding access to the roles of university personnel

Evaluation Procedure and Commission.

A *Commission* summoned by the Director of the Department/Center, who indicates the President of the Commission and the member taking the minutes, will evaluate the applications.

Evaluation procedure. The Commission defines the general evaluation criteria. The qualifications and any other test must ascertain the suitability of the applicant to the research activity. The Commission compiles a ranking and specifies the winning applicant, having regard to the score appointed to experience and qualifications and any other test, as specified by the call.

Awarding of the short research fellowship

Having received the selection documents, and at the outcome of the checks, the Director approves, by his own decree, the classification and the selection procedure reports and makes them public.

Notification, including the start date of the short-term research fellowship, shall be sent to the winning candidate.

The winner must accept the short-term research fellowshipwithin 7 days of receipt of the written notification referred to above, under penalty of revocation. In the event of withdrawal, the short-term research fellowship shall be awarded to the next available candidate, following the order of the final ranking of merit.

The Director Decree approving the selection acts and designating the winner and the Report defining the evaluation criteria or any postponement will be notified through the publication, on the University's webpage from **2024/04/30** (https://www.unive.it/data/12136/)

Access to the selection documents is guaranteed pursuant to the law of August 7th 1990, no. 241 and subsequent amendments and additions and relative internal implementation regulation.
