The Commission, prior to verify the applicants documentation, is summoned to determine the evaluation criteria, according to the rules of eligibility as defined in the Call for the awarding of n. 2 Short Research Fellowships, lasting 12 months each, within the project “Enhance enogasTronomy hEritage to eStAblish and Expand sustainAble Tourism”, acronym “TESTEAT”, project code ITHR0200324, CUP H75E23000170006.

The evaluation of the scientific and professional qualifications will be in conformity with the requirements deemed necessary for carrying out the research activities.

The Selection Committee can assign a maximum **grade up to 100 points** for the evaluation of the scientific and professional qualifications and for the interview.

The Commission decides to specify the evaluation grid for titles, CV, other documents produced by the applicants and for interview, as follows:

Evaluable Qualifications ( <b>max 25 points</b> )	The Commission decides to evaluate the consistency of the training with the profile sought by analyzing the CV proposed by the candidate in



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	<p>relation to the qualification held and any qualifications obtained:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Max 15 points:</b> Master’s Degree or equivalent foreign qualification; A Master’s Degree in Management (LM-77), Statistical Sciences (LM-82), Sociology and social research (LM-88) will be considered a preferred qualification;</li> <li>- <b>Max 5 points:</b> for possession of qualifications higher than a Master’s degree in the scientific-disciplinary fields pertaining to the research in question (e.g. master’s, research doctorate);</li> <li>- <b>Max 5 points:</b> Scientific publications in subjects related to the call for applications.</li> </ul>
<p>Skills, knowledge and skills related to the subjects of the announcement (<b>max 15 points</b>)</p>	<p>The Commission decides to evaluate the skills, knowledge and competences on the basis of the information contained in the CV proposed by the candidate and in the attached documentation. <p>Interview (<b>max 60 points</b>)</p>	<p>The Commission decides to assign during the interview:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Max 18 points:</b> for the degree of understanding shown towards the research project object of the call;</li> <li>- <b>Max 40 points:</b> for the knowledge and skills illustrated by the candidate during the interview for carrying out the research activities required by the project.
