



**Call for n. 1 Short Research Fellowship - Ca' Foscari University of Venice– Temporary Centre
“Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione”**

HAVING REGARD TO	the Article 18, paragraph 5, letter f) of Law No. 240 of December 30, 2010, and subsequent amendments and integrations;
HAVING REGARD TO	the Article 21 quinquies of Law No. 241 of August 7, 1990, and subsequent amendments and integrations;
HAVING REGARD TO	Article 1 bis, paragraph 2, of Decree-Law No. 45 of April 7, 2025, as amended during conversion by Law No. 79 of June 5, 2025, which came into force on June 7, 2025, and which, in Article 4, paragraph 3, of Law No. 210 of July 3, 1998, abolished the favorable tax regime for short-term research fellowships post-graduation, establishing the application of IRPEF and IRAP taxes on such short-term research fellowships;
RECALLED	the Regulation for the establishment of short-term research fellowships for post-graduate activities pursuant to Article 18 of Law No. 240 of December 30, 2010, issued with Rectoral Decree No. 300/2014 of April 14, 2014, and subsequent amendments and integrations;
WHEREAS	the tax treatment of short-term research fellowships is subject to the legislation in force at the time of granting. Even if not expressly referred to in this notice, the applicable tax regime will be that provided for by current legislation pro tempore

The present document in English is to be considered as a mere translation of the provisions of the call which is available in Italian at the following [link](#). The Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” of Ca' Foscari University of Venice, having regard to the Decision of the Deputy Coordinator of the Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” Repertorio n.219/2025 Prot. n. 204085/2025 del 30/07/2025 establishing the research programmes for awarding of the short-term research fellowships in **“Assessment of scientific impact and knowledge transfer in cultural and creative tourism”** lasting 3 months. The expected starting date is indicatively from **September 2025**.

The short-term research fellowship is awarded for the purpose of collaboration with the following research programme of the Temporary Centre “Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” - **abstract**:



This research fellowship aims to critically and systematically analyse the scientific and social impact of activities conducted under Spoke 6 "Tourism, Culture, and Heritage" of the iNEST project. The primary objective is to evaluate how research outputs are assimilated and translated into tangible value for the territory and relevant sectors, with particular attention to their dissemination through scientific publications and their impact on stakeholders in the cultural and tourism systems. The research will unfold in two complementary phases. The first phase will focus on mapping and analysing the scientific production generated by Spoke 6, examining not only quantitative outputs but also their quality, originality, and ability to stimulate academic debate. This approach will provide a comprehensive overview of the project's scientific contribution, highlighting areas of most significant innovation and those that may benefit from further development. The second phase will assess the practical utility of research findings for sector stakeholders, evaluating the extent to which scientific results have been absorbed and applied in real-world contexts. Through the review of documents, reports, and case studies, the study will identify how academic knowledge is transferred to productive and institutional frameworks, generating value for the territory. The analysis will consider both direct impacts—such as the adoption of new methodologies or technologies—and indirect ones, including the formation of collaborative networks and the strengthening of dialogue between research and practice. This structured approach will provide insights into the pathways through which research achieves measurable outcomes, ensuring a robust evaluation of iNEST's contributions to both academia and the cultural tourism ecosystem.

The amount of the short-term research fellowship is equal to Euro 4.800,00 gross percipient and will be subject to taxation according to current regulations. It will be paid at the conclusion of the contract in a single instalment.

Deadline: Tuesday, August 19th, 2025, 12:00 pm

In case the deadline is on Saturdays, Sundays or on holidays it is extended to the first working day thereafter.

Rules of eligibility – Beneficiaries

Citizens belonging to European Union member states and non-community citizens in possession of the following qualifications may take part in the selection:

- a) People with *Master in Master's degree in Environmental and cultural economics (LM76) or equivalent Master degree awarded abroad* and an adequate scientific and professional CV are eligible.

Applicants must hold all the requisites within the call deadline. The qualifications will be evaluated by a Commission that examines the eligibility and qualifications of the candidates and makes a merit rank of them.

Skills required

Advanced skills in cultural and creative management, with proven experience in managing high-impact projects in the tourism and cultural sector. A solid ability to coordinate participatory processes with local and institutional stakeholders is required, combined with familiarity with impact assessment methodologies in the creative industries. The ability to translate research results into operational tools for the sector will be essential, demonstrating sensitivity in mediating between academic requirements and local needs.

Any other evaluable qualifications

Specialisation diplomas or certificates of participation in training activities consistent with the research topics (e.g. summer schools, visiting periods abroad, research awards, etc.).

Incompatibility

The short-term research fellowship may not overlap with:

- a) other scholarships granted in any capacity, apart from those granted by national or foreign research institutes in order to integrate with periods abroad the specific activity foreseen by the work plan of the appointed fellow;
- b) attendance of PhD courses with scholarship and medical specialization, in Italy and abroad;
- c) research grants "assegni di ricerca"

Short-term Research Fellowship holders may carry out self-employed work or occasional or permanent collaborations, as long as this is coherent with the ongoing research, upon approval and on the condition that:

- does not involve a conflict of interest with the specific research activity carried out;
- does not prejudice the university, in relation to the activities carried out.

Subordinate employment contracts holders, in addition to obtaining permission by the university, must provide the authorization of their employer.

In the specific case that the subordinate employment contract started prior to the awarding of the fellowship, compatibility with the existing employment will have to be assessed; if the assessment yields a negative result, the Short-term Research Fellowship will not be awarded; in the case of a positive result, the successful candidate will have to provide the authorization of his/her employer within 15 days.

In the event that the subordinate employment contract will start once the fellowship is ongoing, the successful applicant is required to notify this change at least 30 days before the start of the employment contract for an assessment of compatibility; if the assessment is negative, the fellowship will cease by the start of the employment contract; in the event of a positive outcome, the successful applicant must provide the authorization of his/her employer within 15 days.

The awarding of the short-term research fellowship does not imply the establishment of any employment contract, nor does it give rise to any rights of access to positions of employment at the university

How to apply

Candidates should submit:

1. The application form
2. Applicants must declare in the application, under their own responsibility:
 - educational qualification held;
 - the possession of a residence permit valid at the deadline of the call for applications, in case he/she is a non-European citizen residing in Italy;

-that they understand that the short-term research fellowship is not compatible with the positions referred to in Art. 12 of the present Regulations and current legislation;

- to be medically fit to discharge his/her duties for the fellowship;

-not to have received measures restricting personal freedom at the time of submitting the application;

-not to have a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with any professor belonging to the department or facility issuing the call or with the Rector, the General Manager or a member of the University Board of Directors and that they are aware of the provisions of the Law no 240/2010, Art. 18, para. 1, letter b);

-any benefit under L. 104/92.

3. A CV in European format (<https://www.unive.it/pag/10368/>), duly dated and signed.

4. A copy of a valid identity document (e.g. Identity Card or Passport).

5. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure.

How to submit your application

The candidate, after the uploading, will receive a submission number and an e-mail acknowledging receipt of their application. The candidate, if necessary, could access the procedures for updating any data and materials through the link and submission number provided in the e-mail until the call deadline expires.

Please note that the University can be contacted for any support needs by the candidate until 24 hours prior to the deadline. For further information please contact the email address inest_pnrr@unive.it.

Please note that the University will be closed from 11 to 15 August 2025, so it will not be possible to respond to any requests for support during this week.

Please note that in case of a high number of applications and / or weight of the materials loaded by the candidates the system might become slower. Therefore, it is suggested not to start the process close to the deadline.

Incomplete applications, those without the required data and the compulsory attachments will not be taken into consideration. Furthermore, the applications which, for any reason, reach this University beyond the deadline indicated above cannot be accepted.

The declarations made in the application shall be considered issued in accordance with the DPR no. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments, by candidates entitled to use the simplified administrative certifications permitted by the above decree.

Selection and Evaluation Procedure

The selection is made by assessment of the scientific-professional qualifications, by a Selection Committee appointed by order of the Deputy Coordinator of Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” taking into account, where possible, gender balance.

The Commission compiles a ranking and specifies the winning applicant, having regard to the score appointed to experience and qualifications, as specified by the call. In the event of two or more candidates obtaining the same score at the end of the selection, the younger candidate will be preferred.

Awarding of the short research fellowship

Having received the selection documents, and at the outcome of the checks, the Deputy Coordinator of Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” approves, by his own decree, the classification and the selection procedure reports and makes them public.

Notification, including the start date of the short-term research fellowship, shall be sent to the winning candidate.

The winner must accept the short-term research fellowship within seven days of receipt of the written notification referred to above, under penalty of revocation. In the event of withdrawal, the short-term research fellowship shall be awarded to the next available candidate, following the order of the final ranking of merit.

Publication of the results of all the selection phases shall be published in the online University notice board and on the University website (<https://www.unive.it/data/28824/>).

Access to the selection documents is guaranteed pursuant to the law of August 7th 1990, no. 241 and subsequent amendments and additions and relative internal implementation regulation.

Processing of personal data

Personal data provided by the candidates in their applications for participation in the selection procedures, are processed pursuant to the legislative decree of June 30th 2003, no. 196 and subsequent amendments and additions to EU Regulations 2016/679.
