- to carry out scouting activities of the research results within the University
- to provide qualified support to the process of identification, analysis and development of opportunities for research in partnership with companies and consultancy on the protection and exploitation of research results:
- to carry out research on the state of the art in patent literature, and patentability opinions;
- to prepare freedom to operate reports;
- to prepare trademark pre-existence searches for similarity
