2.3.3. Transcripts of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 8 weeks after the assessment period has finished at our institution.

2.3.4. Termination of Agreement

The above parties agree on the present agreement and the activities listed below replace any other previous agreement. For each academic year, both parties will have the opportunity to review the exchanges. After notifying the partner institution, and if agreed by that institution, amendments of the mobility figures can be made annually. One of the parties may also decide to cancel the agreement, after

having notified the partner institution not later than 1 year prior to the start of respective academic year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
