<p>Course Load</p>	<p>Students must take courses that total 60 UCL credits per semester (30 ECTS/16 US Credits) which is typically 4 courses per semester and 120 credits/60 ECTS/32 US credits for the full year.</p>
<p>Term Dates</p>	<p>2019/20</p> <p>Term 1 (Fall): 23 September – 13 December 2019 Terms 2 & 3 (Spring/Summer): 13 January – 12 June 2020</p> <p>Students arriving in January must stay for the Spring and Summer terms. The dates above encompass both terms and include a vacation period between 27 March and 27 April 2020.</p>
