- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the faculty/academy of the University of Zagreb no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving faculty/academy.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

	APPLICATION DEADLINES - 10 May ∜ winter (1 st) semester / academic year (starting in October) - 10 November ∜ summer (2 nd) semester (starting in March) ! Students that require a VISA are strongly advised to apply and send their documents one month prior to the deadline since the Visa application process may take several weeks or even months.
