Maximum is 30 ECTS per semester, 60ECTS per year.</p> <p><i>What are the course requirements?</i> In case of selection of 4th year courses, advanced knowledge of the subject is highly recommended.</p> <p><i>How do students need to register for the courses?</i> Students need to reserve their spot online through the course selection website.</p>
