Academic Calendar	The Academic Year is divided into two semesters: Winter semester (October - March)   Summer semester (April - September).
	Each semester consists of a fixed lecture period and recess weeks. Examination periods vary according to faculty or department, but usually take place at the end of the lecture period as well as in the first 2-3 weeks after. Students are recommended to book their return travel only after they know their specific examination dates.

Workload	Exchange students are expected to do coursework at the University of Augsburg. Please note that it is <b>not</b> possible to mentor any bachelor, master or PhD theses of Erasmus exchange students or award ECTS for independent research.
	The standard semester workload is 30 ECTS, however, exchange students are flexible and are not required to take a certain number of ECTS by the University of Augsburg. Students should discuss with their home university how many ECTS are expected.
Course Registration	The students can register for their courses after their arrival and enrolment at the University of Augsburg.
Exams	The students can register for the exams during the semester. Normally, the exams will take place during the first recess weeks (deviations possible). If a student has registered for an exam but does not show up, he/she will fail the exam.
Language requirements	The general language of instruction is German and the majority of courses is conducted in German. Some faculties offer a variety of courses in English or in some cases in other languages.  We would like to emphasise the importance of exchange students' language skills not only to successfully study but also to get along with day-to-day life in Germany.

	Erasmus incoming students have to submit a language certificate in German or English. The following level is expected  • for courses in German: German B2 or • for courses in English: English B2 (+ basic skills in German for daily life)  The Language Centre ("Sprachenzentrum") offers free German language classes for all levels. Nomination period for  - Winter Semester 2020/21 or Full Year 2020/21:  April 1st - May 15th 2020  - Summer Semester 2021:  October 1st - November 15th 2020
Application	After being nominated students receive an email with further instructions for admission and will then have to upload the following application documents:  • Photo • Copy of ID or passport • Language Certificate for German or English B2 level (according to intended language of instruction)  Deadline: 31 May 2020 (winter semester or full year)  Deadline: 30 November 2020 (summer semester)

Transcript of Records	The Transcript of Records (ToR) will be prepared and sent to the student's home address after the Erasmus+ Office has received all grades of the student's courses. How long this takes depends on how long the departments take to mark the exams. It may take until the start of the next semester.
Costs	The cost for one exchange semester in Augsburg is approximately € 4.000 per semester or € 670 per month (including food, insurance, housing etc). Costs may vary according to accommodation form and lifestyle.  At the start of each semester students have to pay a student services fee including the semester ticket: € 114, 85 each semester.
Orientation Programme	Each semester, an orientation programme is organised before the start of lectures. Details will be provided by the International Office to all nominated students.
