Study Options	<p>Students usually need to take at least 50% of their courses within the department they are admitted to, but may choose up to 50% as electives from other departments (subject to availability, course tutor approval and meeting any prerequisites). Course Load	Students must take courses that total 60 UCL credits per semester (30 ECTS/16 US Credits) which is typically 4 courses per semester and 120 credits/60 ECTS/32 US credits for the full year.

Entry requirements

Entry requirements

You should normally have completed, or expect to complete, two years of study at university level prior to entry to UCL.

The typical minimum entry requirement is a cumulative GPA of 3.3 / 4.0 (or equivalent), but some subject areas require at least a 3.7 and may have additional prerequisites. Admissions Tutors need to be confident that you have enough knowledge to take classes alongside regular degree students at UCL.
