Arranged Accommodation	Application for a room in one of our halls of residence is possible with the application. However, the past has shown there are not as many rooms available in the halls of residence as the number of exchange students that apply for them. We will provide further information on the search for private accommodation in Heilbronn along with the dispatch of the Letter of Acceptance. Tutors will help incoming students with the search for a private accommodation.
Accommodation Costs per Month	Student halls about 300 €, private accommodation 250 – 450 €
Cost of Living Expenses	Approx. 853 € (incl. rent, food, health insurance, broadcasting, leisure/culture, clothing)
Insurance	Valid health insurance is mandatory for enrolment , monthly fee approx. 100 € (not for students with EHIC). A personal liability insurance is recommended.
