Can I become an exchange student at the Department of Economics?

If your own university holds an exchange agreement either with the University of Copenhagen or with the Department of Economics directly - then you can apply as an exchange student. You are then exempted from paying tuition fee

Which courses can I do?

As an exchange student at the Department of Economics, you have access to all our bachelor and master courses.

Almost all our courses require high levels of competencies in economic theory, **mathematics** and **econometrics**. When choosing courses as an exchange student, you **must read the prerequisites of each course** and consider carefully whether you meet the requirements or not.

Please be honest to yourself - the courses are more than just some interesting titles. You need to read the course descriptions thoroughly and take the stated lists of prerequisites very seriously. You are **not qualified for a 3rd year undergraduate** course or a master's level course with a background in eg. "Econ 101" only.

For you to get the most out of your studies, we recommend that you have completed at least 2 years of full-time studies at your home university.
