French Academic calendar	<ul> <li>Academic calendar in France begins in September and ends in June, depending in which academic department your future outgoing student are going to study.</li> <li>An Academic Year (AY) is divided in semesters like follows: <ul> <li>1st semester (Fall semester) from September to end January</li> <li>2nd semester (Spring semester) from January to end June (eventually in July if retake exam)</li> </ul> </li> <li>An AY is also punctuated by vacations, examinations and also retake examinations.</li> </ul>	
Erasmus+ Certificate of stay	Actual mobility dates are confirmed thanks to the certificates of arrival and departure or thanks to the certificate of stay. Certificates are signed at the arrival and departure of the student. The beginning date of the mobility corresponds to the 1st day the student arrives at the Incoming Mobility Office or to her/his attendance to our integration event. The end date of the mobility corresponds to the last day of the exam or the last retake exam at CY Cergy Paris Université.

Final admission for an exchange program	The Incoming Mobility Team will send the application to the selection committee at the academic department in which your students wish to study.
	Final admission for an exchange program will be effective only AFTER the approval of the application by the selection committee.
	Students will then receive an acceptation email (for Erasmus+ Students) or an invitation letter (non-EU Students).
