We operate a personal tutor system; each incoming student helpers

receives a tutor (student) who helps prior to and during the semester(s), they help integration to cultural and social life.

- The academic year is divided into two semesters. The 1st semester (Autumn term) starts at the beginning of September, while the 2nd semester (Spring term) starts at the beginning of February.
- Classes are held from mid-September to mid-December and mid-February to mid-May. Students applying to the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences are recommended to arrive one week before the semester starts for orientation. At the end of each semester, students have an exam period for oral and/or written exams. There is a one-week break in the middle of each semester (autumn and spring break). It is possible to travel home during the pre-exam/exam period in Winter for the Christmas holidays after consulting with the teachers about exam dates at the beginning of the semester.
- Please bear in mind that the Erasmus period should also cover the exam term! Exams can also be taken one week before the exam period during the pre-examination week.
- The Humanities and Social Sciences welcomes MA and BA students. Students wishing to spend their Erasmus mobility period at our Faculty are very welcome. We are happy to assist students with their thesis work, as well.
- Most of our foreign language courses run in English, although we have courses in German, French and Italian, as well. We kindly ask prospective Erasmus students to get information about the available course list at our website 5-6 weeks before their Erasmus period starts. - A Welcome Programme is offered for all international students in the frame of the Orientation Day. Students will be introduced to different aspects of being a student in Hungary through practical information. We organize an Orientation week during which the students are shown around in the capital and the Campuses of the University, they get to know one another from all the four faculties via interesting social and cultural programmes.
- Language courses: PPCU offers Hungarian Language Course to non-native speakers during the whole semester.
