Health Care	<p>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) entitles EU citizens to healthcare in Poland on the basis of EU regulations on coordination of social security systems. Students from non-EU countries without the EHIC or any other health insurance may apply for a voluntary insurance from the Polish National Health Fund [NFZ].</p>
