<p>Nomination Procedure and deadlines for students</p> <p>DEADLINES for nomination and files sent by UNS partner:</p> <p>30 June (for winter semester)</p> <p>15 November (for summer semester)</p>	<p>STUDENTS</p> <p>Home institution sends student nominations for a study exchange, with the following documents of the candidate:</p> <p>OBLIGATORY:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Transcript of records 2. Erasmus+ learning agreement (<i>proposal</i>) 3. Copy of identity page of passport 4. Student CV (<i>Europass format</i>) 5. English language certificate 6. Contact with a potential supervisor or mentor (<i>only for PhDs</i>) <p>All documents must be in English.</p> <p>The host institution does the internal evaluation (faculties evaluate student documents) and afterwards confirm the selection.</p> <p>STAFF</p> <p>Home institution sends staff nominations for a training/teaching period with the following documents of the candidate:</p> <p>OBLIGATORY:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. CV 2. Staff Teaching Agreement / Staff Training Agreement 3. Copy of identity page of passport 4. Pre-invitation letter from academic host at UNS <p>All documents must be in English and delivered well in advance of the realisation of the mobility.</p>

Selection for KA1	After the application documents have been evaluated at the respective UNS faculty, selected students/staff will receive an invitation letter. They are also advised to read all relevant information regarding their arrival (Regulation of Stay, Welcome guide, Information on accommodation, etc.)
Arrival at UNS (obligatory central registration of arrival and departure of ALL Erasmus+ incoming grantholders)	<p>All incoming grantholders need to register their ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE in the central International Office of the University when the mobility starts and ends.</p> <p>Apart from filling in the arrival form (and later departure form), <u>grantholders are expected to provide:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Copy of Passport- Copy of Learning Agreement (students)- Copy of Grant Agreement (students and staff)- Copy of Mobility Agreement (staff) <p>All Erasmus+ grant holders are asked to send an e-mail announcing their registration in the International Relations Office and <u>are advised to come in the period between 10-13h.</u></p>
Regulation of Stay at the Police Department in Novi Sad	<p>Incoming students and staff have the obligation to register at the Police Department upon arrival to Serbia/Novi Sad within 24 hours.</p> <p>http://www.uns.ac.rs/images/doc/medjunarodna/UNS_Regulation_of_Stay.pdf</p> <p>Both University/Faculty coordinators (IROs) can issue the certificate on Erasmus+ mobility to the grant holder for this purpose upon registration.</p>
Welcome Week	<p>Welcome Week (February and October) is organised jointly by the International Relations Office of the University, the International Relations Offices of the faculties and the Erasmus Student Network (ESN) Novi Sad.</p> <p>More information on activities is available on the ESN Novi Sad website http://novisad.esn.rs/ and the facebook group https://www.facebook.com/esn.novisad</p>
Accommodation	<p>All Erasmus+ students are supported by the ESN Novi Sad in finding an appropriate private accommodation. Please note that places in student dorms are not offered in Erasmus+ as an alternative, given that there is highly limited dorm capacity for foreign students.</p> <p>Final decision on private accommodation remains the responsibility of the incoming student/staff.</p>
