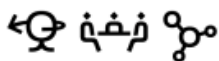

Health Insurance	Foreign students who do not have social security valid for the entire period of their exchange programme in France must apply to join the French social security scheme by registering on the website https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/ . They must attach the following documents in support of their application: – their identity document (national identity card, passport, etc.) – a document stating their enrolment in a higher education institution for the academic year in question (to prove their student status) – their bank details (in order to receive refunds) – a civil status document, needed for the creation of their identification number (commonly known as a “social security number”). For example: a full copy of their birth certificate OR an extract of their birth certificate featuring their parents’ names OR any document issued by a consulate OR a family record book OR a marriage certificate – foreign students must also present a regular residence permit Once they have registered online, students receive a temporary social security number and can print a certificate showing their entitlement to benefits. <p>Student and Campus Life Contribution (CVEC):</p>	<p>Incoming exchange students are not subject to the CVEC</p> <p>The determining factor for not being subject to the CVEC is that they do not pay registration fees at the University of Strasbourg.</p> <p>They do not have to contact the CROUS.</p> <p>At Unistra, the Pass CAMPUS (obtained through administrative registration) allows access to sport (SUAPS) and to the University Service for Preventive Medicine and Health Promotion (SUMPS) and also acts as your Carte Culture (Culture Card).</p>
