Application for Incoming Students	<p>After receiving a nomination from the partner university, we will send an application form and explain the further process of the enrolment to the students.</p> <p>Please note, that we can only admit Erasmus+ students after receiving an official nomination!</p> <p>Deadline for the submission of the application documents: June 30 for the winter semester and/or the full academic year and December 31 for the summer semester</p>	
Language of Instruction	<p>The main language of instruction for undergraduate studies is German. We recommend a minimum level of B1 for incoming students.</p> <p>A language certificate is mandatory for the following areas:</p> <p>German language and literature studies: B2 (CEFR) German</p> <p>Psychology: B1 (CEFR) German</p> <p>Medicine Bachelor: B1 (CEFR) German – Medicine Master and Internships: B2 (CEFR) German</p>

Please note that we cannot guarantee that all students will be offered a room by the International Office. If the number of applications exceeds the number of rooms available, we will not be able to accommodate every student. Costs of Living (estimated)	<p>Semester fee: tbd (including public transport) Accommodation: from 350 EUR/month Food: 180 EUR/month Plus private expenses Living expenses average between 750 - 950 EUR per month (BA/MA students). The actual costs may vary. The proof of finance demanded by the visa office is 11.208 EUR/year (934/month) for student visa holders.</p>
Semester Fee	<p>There are no tuition fees applicable at the Saarland University. However, it is mandatory for students to pay a small fee corresponding to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The administrative cost related to the establishment of the Student ID card - The semester ticket which allows for public transportation in the federal state of Saarland. <p>The fee for exchange students tbd per semester. Health Insurance	<p>A valid health insurance is mandatory for the enrolment: European Health Insurance Card delivered to all EU citizens. All incoming Erasmus students will be provided with detailed information about the health insurance (EU and Non-EU citizens).</p>
