Housing information (if any)	Unlike other Spanish cities in Spain, the cost of living in Jaén is very affordable and accommodation is relatively cheap. Jaén is also one of the safest cities in Spain. The University of Jaén offers on-campus accommodation through the Colegio Mayor Domingo el Savio and University Apartments. There are rooms and apartments which are exclusively reserved for international students, although the
