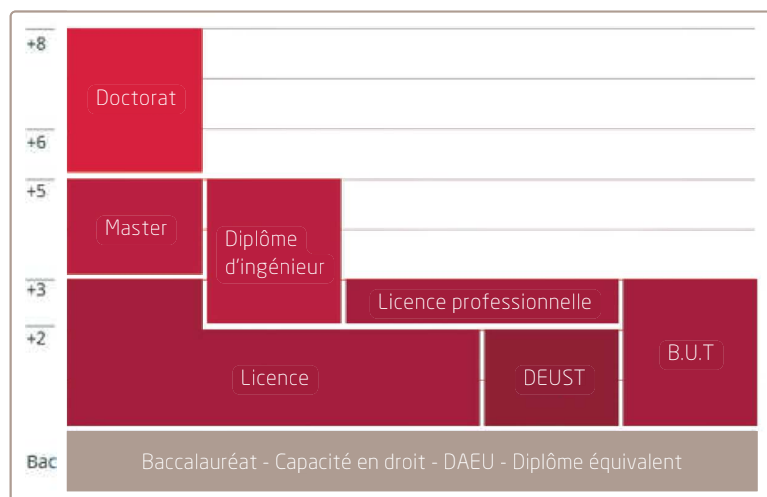

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

- Autumn semester (1st semester): June 17th
- Spring semester (2nd semester): November 15th

APPLICATION CONTENT:

- Learning agreement duly filled in, signed, and stamped by home institution.
- Transcript of records for the past two or three years
- Document from the home university certifying that the applicant has a B2 level in French (or in English if the applicant chooses only courses in English; except for students coming from English-speaking countries)

HOUSING:

The central International Relations Office of the University will help students find accommodation in Poitiers (university residence, private apartment, house sharing etc.). Students are required to complete and validate the online “logement” (= accommodation) application form on the University of Poitiers website by **June 30th** (for the 1st semester) and by **November 30th** for the 2nd semester.
