Students must, however, enrol in at least 51% of their total ECTS credits at the Faculty of Human Sciences. Online Application	Students will receive an email with the hyperlink to the online application form after being nominated by their home university. Students should submit their application online and provide additional documents: transcript of records and identity card or passport.

We suggest students start looking for accommodation well in advance, due to the high-level of demand in Lisbon nowadays. Universidade Católica Portuguesa has a private <u>Female Student Residence Hall</u> in Lisbon. Students should contact the Residence Hall for further information.
