

Traineeship / internship / placement students

UiT welcomes applications for traineeships (e.g. practical placements, internships, lab work, or research related to thesis supervision) from:

- Students from **partner institutions**
- Guest students from **Erasmus+ institutions in Europe only**

Duration requirements:

- **Minimum:** 2 months
- **Maximum:** 1 academic year per study cycle (BA, MA, or PhD), even if the semesters are non-contiguous
