Application procedure	<p>Step 1: official nomination by the home university using the nomination link sent by our international relations team, or also possible by email to incoming@sciencespo-saintgermain.fr.</p> <p>Step 2: nominated students are e-mailed an application form to complete and the list of supporting documents to submit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - last university grades - proof of a B2 level in French or in English - passport copy - photo in jpeg format (for the Sciences Po Saint-Germain-en-Laye student card) <p>Step 3: upon reception of the complete application, the international office emails the student his/her acceptance letter and information to prepare the exchange.</p>

Language requirements	<p>Non-French and non-English native-speakers will need to provide a language certificate showing a B2 or higher level in French or in English as defined in the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference) – Accepted certificate in French: DELF, DALF, TCF, CEFP / in English: TOEFL iBT 72 minimum, IELTS 6 minimum.</p> <p>The certificate may also be issued by a language teacher or by the home university.</p>
French as a Foreign Language	<p>French as a foreign language is offered, all year long, free of charge for 3 different levels: full beginner, basic and intermediate (55 hours per semester, twice a week).</p>

<p>Courses</p>	<p>The main language of instruction is French, but there is a wide variety of courses also available in English in the main subjects: Political Science, International Relations, Law, Economics, Sociology and History. Some lectures are specifically designed for international students, “International students only”.</p> <p>Exchange students are required to register to a minimum of 6 credits ECTS per semester, and up to 35 credits ECTS per semester.</p> <p>Course catalogue : https://www.sciencespo-saintgermainenlaye.fr/en/courses/</p>
<p>Visa</p>	<p>Citizens from EU/EEA countries do not need a visa to enter France.</p> <p>All other nationalities must check if they need a visa on: https://france-visas.gouv.fr/en/assistant-visa</p>

<p>Estimated cost of living</p>	<p>900 € - 1100 € per month</p>
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>The international relations team provides support and guidance to students looking for a suitable accommodation in the area, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - studios or shared rooms in private student halls - accommodation in families with an international background
<p>Airport pick-up service</p>	<p>Free of charge upon registration from non-European countries, on specified days before the Welcome Days.</p>
<p>Health insurance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - EU/EEA nationals should apply and obtain the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) for reduced cost or free medical treatment - All non-European students should enroll in the French national health insurance (free of charge): https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr
<p>Student life</p>	<p>All exchange students are provided the same access to campus facilities as local students (library, social and cultural events, sports...).</p> <p>Incoming students are put in touch with our student association and assigned a “buddy” who helps them when they arrive and during their stay.</p>
