Documents submission – deadlines for <u>Students</u>	For the Fall semester & Academic year – 1st of June For the Spring semester – 1st of January Students submit the application via link that each of them receives after their home university submits the nominations
Language requirements	<u>B2 level of English</u> Accepted Certificates: <u>IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge, Toles, TOEIC, LCCI, Pearson</u> * Unless English is a native language of instruction at the home University (in such cases, the <u>confirmation</u> concerning language of instruction is <u>required</u>)

Copy of one's medical insurance (in the case of EU citizens – please submit your European Health Insurance Card, which should be also valid for the entire exchange period; non-EU citizens are asked to submit a proper insurance document with a coverage in the amount of at least EUR 30.000); 3. Passport-size photo in the JPG format; 4. Student's transcript of records; 5. Copy of one's B2 Certificate of English (accepted certificates – listed above) unless the language of instruction set for the student's curriculum is English or if English

	is the student's native language. We accept language certificates which confirm at least B2 level of English. Also, students can provide us with an official confirmation of their level of English – issued by their home universities.

Course selection Procedure Registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> List of courses is available at https://www.kozminski.edu.pl/pl/spolecznosc/incoming-students section: List of courses and classes. Students select by themselves their preferred courses in Kozminski's online system (selection needs to be approved by student's home university). Access to the platform will be given 2 weeks before the semester starts. Undergraduate and graduate students may choose courses from Bachelor and/or Master programs (selection needs to be approved by student's home university). Law students may choose courses from Law and Business studies as well from both levels. Polish course for beginners is available but not mandatory.
Signing the Learning Agreement (deadlines)	Fall semester – before mobility: second half of October; during mobility: end of November Spring semester – before mobility: first half of March; during mobility: first half of April
Course load per semester	30 ECTS credits per semester (total number depends mainly on home university's requirements, students have to attend at least 1 course during the mobility at KU). Exchange students <u>are not allowed to take more than 35 ECTS</u>
