



<b>Semester dates</b> (exam period included)	<p>Autumn semester: 17 August 2026 - 11 December 2026 Spring semester: 18 January 2027 - 21 May 2027</p> <p><a href="https://www.haaga-helia.fi/en/academic-year">https://www.haaga-helia.fi/en/academic-year</a></p> <p>Haaga-Helia organizes a compulsory 3-day on-site orientation for exchange students at the beginning of every semester. The orientation is held a week before the beginning of lessons.</p> <p><b>Sports Coaching and Management exchange studies are possible only during autumn semester or the whole academic year.</b></p>
<b>Nomination period</b>	<p>For autumn semester and the whole academic year: <b>20<sup>th</sup> March – 15<sup>th</sup> April 2026</b> For spring semester: <b>25<sup>th</sup> September – 20<sup>th</sup> October 2026</b></p> <p>Partner universities will receive the nomination link one week before the nomination period starts.</p>
<b>Application period</b>	<p>For autumn semester and the whole academic year: <b>20<sup>th</sup> March – 25<sup>th</sup> April 2026</b> For spring semester: <b>25<sup>th</sup> September – 30<sup>th</sup> October 2026</b></p> <p>Acceptance letters to accepted students will be sent within 2 weeks of the application deadline.</p>
