Deadline for sending Online Learning Agreement	Autumn semester: June 1 st Summer semester: December 1 st Important: Incoming Erasmus students have to take <u>at least 60%</u> of their workload from the faculty of the receiving institution that coordinates the bilateral agreement. The rest of their workload can be made up of courses from different faculties. This decision will be subject to the capacities of the faculties.

Erasmus+ agreements Extension of Mobility stays	<p>Please note that: the number of students each institution will send may by no means exceed the number of students mentioned in this agreement. More specifically shorter periods of stay do not allow for the sending of more students, i.e. on an exchange of 1 student for 10 months, a partner cannot send 2 students for 5 months, not even if their stay covers different semesters. The numbers of months per student the partners have agreed on are fixed. An extension of stay is only possible, when e. g. a student is nominated for 5 months, but the partners have agreed on an exchange of 1 student for 10 months. Students should apply early in advance for an extension of stay, at least one month before the regular stay ends. A written acceptance of both partners (incl. International Office) is mandatory and should not exceed the number of months agreed per students. Each party will take this into consideration when organizing student selection.</p> <p><i>It is highly appreciated to contact our Incoming Exchange Officer early in advance (e.g. November) if partners or students have any question concerning extension of their mobility stay (Winter semester to summer semester, not vice versa)</i></p>
Certificate of Arrival	Our International Office will issue a database driven Certificate of Arrival. Word documents are not accepted. Due to summer vacations in August Certificate will not be issued during that time.
Certificate of Stays	Our university will issue a database driven Certificate of Stay. Word documents are not accepted. Due to summer vacations in August Certificate will not be issued during that time.

Therefore, we need the following documents 6 weeks before you come to Göttingen.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Residence title of the EU country in which you are studying. The residence title must be issued for study purposes 2. Passport or ID 3. Proof of financial means showing that you have at least € 934 per month to support yourself (e.g. copy of bank statement, scholarship, or letter from parents) 4. Proof of health insurance (EHIC card, otherwise a German statutory health insurance is strongly suggested) 5. Home address and your address in Göttingen, if you already have one 6. Complete address of your home university <p>After the approval of the BAMF, there is no need to apply for a visa for study purposes in Germany.</p>
