

## GRADING SCHEME:

### UNDERGRADUATE:

The grading scale is from 1 to 10. (5) Is considered the minimum pass mark.



### GRADUATE:

Units are graded on a scale of 01 to 100 points with the following qualitative equivalence:

**FAIL** 01 - 59      **PASS** 60 - 100

The minimum mark to pass each unit and the final dissertation is 60.
