**Certificate Absence Sexual Crime**

Spanish Law L.O. 8/2015 - 22nd. July states the following:

“Students taking PRACTICES (STAGE- PLACEMENT ) at university (this applies mainly to Medicine, Nursing, Education, Social Work, Psychology, etc.) and are going to be in contact with children and minors, must bring a CRIMINAL RECORD issued by the home country authorities. Otherwise, they will not be allowed to perform practical classes in schools, hospitals, etc.

**Language Requirement:**

**Spanish:**

At least a B2 level is recommended for attending regular courses taught in Spanish. (Intermediate-High/Advanced-Low according to ACTFL).

**Admitted language assessments:**

- ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages): levels Intermediate-high or Advanced-low
- DELE B2
- SIELE Global B2
- Home University language assessment test
- Language proficiency report issued by a Spanish language instructor that states the student has the reading, oral, writing and listening skills equivalent to ACTFL Intermediate-high or



Advanced-low or ECFRL B2.

- 6 semester courses of Spanish language (not culture or civilization courses)

**English:** for non-native speakers, at least a B2 level is recommended for attending regular courses taught in English.

Admitted language assessments:

- Cambridge English: First Certificate
- Trinity Integrated Skills: B2
- iBT TOEFL: 72
- Language proficiency report issued by an English language instructor that states the student has the reading, oral, writing and listening skills equivalent to ECFRL B2 or ACTFL Intermediate-high or Advanced-low.

**Accommodation:**

Shared apartments with other students in town.

**Estimated cost of housing:**

325/450 euros/month aprox. (shared apartment)

**Estimated cost of meals:**

75 euros/week (groceries or university cafeteria)

**Visa:**

All nationals not holding a passport from a European Union country need a valid visa to enter the country. Information about Consulates of the Kingdom of Spain worldwide can be found at:

**Health insurance:**

All nationals from a European Union country must apply



for the European Health Care Card at the Social Security Authorities of their home country.

Citizens from a non-European Union country must contract a health insurance with coverage regular and emergency health care.

General insurance: following Regional Education Authorities requirements all students must contract a liability and accident insurance upon registration. It has a 7-euro fee.

In order to have an adequate and effective treatment, international students under chronic treatment or therapy, must bring a medical report with them stating diagnosis, drugs prescribed and travel clearance.

**Transcript of records:**

Incoming students: official electronic transcripts of records are uploaded in the student portal by early February (fall) or mid-July (spring and FY).

Outgoing students: we do accept official electronic transcripts. They must be sent to [internacionales@um.es](mailto:internacionales@um.es)
