Requirements for the extension of a student's mobility:

The exchange period can be extended also for the spring semester. The application must be submitted to the Secretariat of the Department. at least a month before the end of the winter semester.

Before applying, you must have your home University's Official approval document.

Extension of the spring semester is not allowed.

Deadline for providing the document at eras-inc@ionio.gr: June 30th from Term 1 to Term 2 / September 30rd from Term 2 to the following academic year.

If a student from a partner institution wishes to extend the duration of his/her mobility from a semester to a full-year stay, please take the information below into account:

 - o first have the approval of the home institution;

Academic calendar:

Our academic calendar is divided into 2 semesters, the ongoing calendar is available, but the general calendar is the following:

1st semester (Winter Term): from **beginning of October** until **mid-January**

2nd session exams*: from mid-January until mid- February

2nd semes<u>ter (Spring Term): from mid-February</u> until mid-June

2nd session exams*: from **beginning of June** until **mid-June**

Physical presence at the beginning of the semester is <u>mandatory</u> in order to register at the Departments.

A fully signed Learning Agreement before arrival is required to ensure that your students will be able to follow the proposed course program during their mobility.

d- Language requirements

Erasmus students are encouraged to have sufficient knowledge of the Greek language since most of the

courses are taught in Greek. However, for Erasmus students only, courses can also be offered on a

tutorial basis in one of the main European languages and the examinations have the form of essay

writing or written exams. There are also practical courses found in Departments such as the Music Dept,

Audiovisual Arts Dept. etc. Extra courses (accredited with ECTS) are offered especially for Incoming

Erasmus students at an interdepartmental level.

• Main Language of instruction and examination: Greek

Recommended level: B1

The OLS supports the Greek language. Students are invited to log in the system and register for the

course.

The Ionian University offers Greek Language Course for Erasmus students during the academic year

(October- June), free of charge, accredited with six (6) ECTS per semester.

Enrolment on this course is compulsory.

• Second Language: English

Required level: B2

Regarding the B2 English level, students can be admitted after presenting a copy of the result of the OLS

English Language Assessment.

Please refer to the Erasmus+ interinstitutional agreement signed with your institution for eventual

exemptions.

g- Insurance

Health insurance is compulsory.

EU Citizens

- A. EU citizens should have with them the E.H.I.C. card valid for the previewed study period issued by the relevant Heath Institution in the student's Home Country (http://ec.europa.eu/social/main.jsp?catId=559).
- B. In addition to the above requirements, it is strongly recommended that all students have an insurance policy covering at least the following requirements:
- 1. Personal Accident (including repatriation)
- 2. Death (including repatriation) In case of a special health problem or if you are an Erasmus Traineeship Student or if you don't have the EHIC card with you during your trip, it is mandatory to have a private insurance for the Erasmus period (both for health insurance and civil liability).

Non-EU Citizens

Non-EU Citizens are strongly recommended to have health insurance coverage for the previewed Erasmus+ study period before leaving their home country [including personal accident, death (including repatriation), Civil liability].

The students will present the insurance upon arrival at the Host Institution's Secretariat.

The document must be translated in English in order to be accepted.

ATTENTION! All Erasmus students that intent to stay for a year (two semesters) must take into consideration that, if their EHIC Card is not valid for the whole semesters' period, the police officer will not be able to renew their Residence Permit. As a result, they should either have it renewed in time or find private insurance.
